Commemorated on 11 August:

Clare of Assisi

Born in 1193 in Assisi, Clare caught the joy of a new vision of the gospel from hearing Francis preach. Escaping from home, first to the Benedictines and then to a Béguine-style group, she chose a contemplative way of life when she founded her own community. This group lived in corporate poverty understood as dependence on God, with a fresh, democratic lifestyle.

Clare became the first woman to write a religious Rule for women, and in it showed great liberty of spirit in dealing with earlier prescriptions. During the long years after Francis' death, she supported his earlier companions in their desire to remain faithful to his vision.
