

We are looking for a building in Southwark or Lambeth that we can purpose to support those experiencing homelessness. During the winter it would serve as our community night shelter and in the summer months as a day centre service where we can operate a range of holistic services to support people in need.

Ideally it would include:

- a minimum of 14 individual rooms
- shower and toilet facilities
- a kitchen with storage and a food preparation area large enough to accommodate resident guests and volunteers
- a communal area that can be used for dining facilities, relaxation and other group guest services such as classes - and in the non-shelter months serve as a day centre facility
- a separate room that can be used as an on-site office for staff
- laundry facilities (or a suitable space that could be turned into a laundry)
- outdoor space guests can access

We are open to venues that may already provide such facilities or a building that we could adapt.
